


The Parkwood Pup QRP Key

The Parkwood Pup is a small straight key for portable or fixed station use. A pair of rare-earth magnets provide variable tension. The parts are machined from C-360 brass and the fittings are stainless steel and nickel-plated brass. Instrument-grade ball bearings support the lever. A skirted plastic knob is provided.

Adjustments

Set the key travel with the screw at the front of the key and use the knurled thumb-nut to lock it into place. To set the tension, loosen the slide lock thumb-nut near the center of the key. Move the tension slide back or forward (bringing the magnets more or less into alignment) until the desired tension is produced, then lock the slide into place with the thumb-nut.

Connection

The key is fitted with a standard 1/8" phone plug in its base. Use a male-to-male phone-plug jumper with the appropriate connector to connect the key to your transmitter.

Price of the Parkwood Pup as shown is \$75.00. You can specify knob color of blue, black, red, or green.
